BASIC RULES OF PLAY

Grading:

Age grades this year are “Open (15+ years)” and “Tamariki (8 to 14 years)”. Please note that for children under 8 we will have a special area with games and activities throughout the day. If children younger than 8 wish to take part in the team events, they may do so providing parents/caregivers accept all risk.

Base rules and guidelines for each sport:

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Other:

- Referees will be directed by the fundamental handbook rules, More detailed information will be sent out once team registrations are received and confirmed.
- Adult players can only play for one team in each sport, however you can play in more than one sport
- It is preferred that teams wear some form of uniform (singlets, shirts, bibs, etc.)
- Teams are to be assembled at least 15min before the start of their games
- Officials must be informed at time of team registrations/check-in if there is any change to your teams,
- Players must be a member of the iwi or a spouse for the team they play for. Exception/s will be where Iwi are combined to field full teams or at the discretion of the officials.
- Iwi may register up to 2 teams per sport/grade.
- We expect all participants (players and supporters) will be respectful, display the best sportsmanship both on and off the field/court, and remember that the kaupapa is about whanaungatanga.
